When did your Dive Guides last renew their EFR certifications or practice their EFR skills? What if the only EFR trained person on the boat has an accident? Does the boat crew know what to do in case of an accident, how to resuscitate a patient or simply stem bleeding? What about your staff in the dive base, restaurant and other areas of your site? Who of your staff can set-up and apply the emergency oxygen kit? Do they know how to prevent the dangers associated with oxygen?

Regardless of all possible precaution, accidents or injuries may occur during a dive trip or on land. From minor incidents like a cut, itching skin from contact with marine life, more severe situations like chocking from a piece of food in the windpipe or a heat stroke to decompression sickness or heart attacks.

So you better be prepared so that your staff – on the boat and on land – can take appropriate action and help.

We are certified Emergency First Response Instructors (First and Secondary Care, incl. Care for Children, CPR and AED) as well as Emergency Oxygen Provider Instructors.
